

Student Representation within Institutional Governance at Northern Technical University

Under the patronage of the President of Northern Technical University, Professor Dr. Aliaa Abbas Al-Attar, the Technical Engineering College / Mosul organized democratic elections to select student representatives across academic departments as well as the College Student Representative for the academic year 2025–2026. The elections were conducted under the supervision of the Assistant Dean for Student Affairs, Professor Dr. Haitham Mohammed Waddaallah, and in the presence of Heads of Scientific Departments, ensuring transparency, fairness, and institutional oversight throughout the process. Following a collaborative and democratic voting process, student Abdulrahman Ziad Ali was elected as the official representative of the college students. The elected representative is responsible for conveying students' perspectives, academic concerns, and developmental suggestions to college of Engineering, thereby strengthening participatory governance and enhancing institutional decision-making. In parallel, academic departments have implemented structured mechanisms for selecting first-year student representatives under departmental supervision. These representatives serve as formal communication channels between students and academic leadership, contributing to improved organization of academic affairs and fostering a culture of responsibility, cooperation, and active engagement within the university community. This initiative reflects Northern Technical University's commitment to inclusive governance by integrating student voices into institutional structures and supporting active student participation in shaping the educational environment and university policies.
